



Privacy Policy

Introduction

Protecting your personal information is important to us. We have, therefore, created this statement in accordance with the EU data protection regime introduced by the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation 2016/679 the “GDPR”). GDPR strengthens and unifies data protection across the European Union. It also applies to all organizations that hold or process the personal information of EU-based individuals. The legislation is intended to ensure that all personal information held by organizations (including, for example, an email address) which might allow you, as an individual, to be identified, is accurate and secure and there is no miss-use of personal information by that organization. This document sets out how the Dynamic Technologies Trading collects, uses and safeguards the personal information that you, as an individual, provide to us. This statement covers all communication with Dynamic Technologies Trading, including users of Dynamic Technologies Trading websites. In this privacy statement: “you” or “your” refers to you as an individual and not to any legal entity (such as your employer) which you may be representing by viewing our websites or communicating with us “our”, “ours”, “we” or “us” refers to Dynamic Technologies Trading. Please note, if you provide personal information relating to other individuals (for example contact details in a work context), you must either advise those individuals of the details of this statement or provide them with a link to this statement. By providing your information to Dynamic Technologies Trading you consent to the collection and use of your personal information in the manner set out below. The privacy statement covers only Dynamic Technologies Trading, it does not cover the privacy policies of other entities which may be accessible through, or linked to, any Dynamic Technologies Trading website or communication. We will not notify you separately of any changes or updates to this privacy statement, but instead will post them to this page. Any change or update will be effective immediately upon posting. Information Collected by Dynamic Technologies Trading

When you visit a Dynamic Technologies Trading website or contact with Dynamic Technologies Trading, and when providing any services to you, Dynamic Technologies Trading may collect personally identifiable information about you from information provided by you. This can include the following information relating to you: name, address (residential or corporate), geographical location, email address, contact details, corporate contact information, correspondence records. We may also obtain personal information on you from other public sources.

Purposes of Processing and Legal basis for processing

Generally, Dynamic Technologies Trading will use the personal information provided by you to:

Create an account allowing access to detailed information about the funds we manage. Facilitate the administration of a website account. Email updates relating to the products and services that Dynamic Technologies Trading and related parties offer Respond to queries or provide services to you. Maintain or update contact data about you or a third party (for example your employer) within Dynamic

Technologies Trading's systems. Enable us to act on any agreement with you, your employer or any other relevant third party. Provide to any third parties that may host, maintain or manage services for Dynamic Technologies Trading, solely to the extent necessary to fulfil their hosting, maintenance or service management functions. We will never share your personal information with others for marketing purposes, unless you have given us your explicit permission to do so.

Where you have done so, we will only share your information with:

Those service providers that help us manage our marketing activities; or with related parties for the purposes of providing you with related products and services. Accordingly, you understand that we may use your personal information for the purposes as described above, provided that we are acting in a fair, transparent and accountable manner and that we have taken appropriate steps to prevent the activity having any unwarranted impact on you and also noting your right to object to such use, as discussed below. Should we wish to use your personal information for other purposes (including, if applicable, any purpose that requires your additional consent), we will contact you.

The categories of nonpublic personal information which Dynamic Technologies Trading shall collect include:

1. Information provided by the customer when opening an account, or to process a transaction, such as name, address, assets, bank information, prior trading experience, etc.;
2. Information used to verify the identity of the customer, including copies of government issued identification materials such as passports, driver's licenses, and credit reports
3. Information resulting from transactions between the customer and Dynamic Technologies Trading or an affiliate of Dynamic Technologies Trading, such as withdrawal and deposit forms;
4. Information derived from customer's navigation and usage of Dynamic Technologies Trading's website and online platforms, including account trading statements;

Usage of Personal Information

Dynamic Technologies Trading may use the information collected from you to verify your identity and contact information. Dynamic Technologies Trading may also use this information to establish and setup your trading or demo account, issue an account number and a secure password, maintain your account activity, and contact you with account information. Should you close your account, Dynamic Technologies Trading will retain your information, but only use it to comply with regulatory requirements and to periodically contact you to offer you the opportunity to reactivate your account or participate in other valuable offers.

Recipients of Data and Transfer of Data

Dynamic Technologies Trading may disclose personal information to: Entities within the Dynamic Technologies Trading group, service providers of the business it manages, its service providers and their respective affiliates engaged by Dynamic Technologies Trading to process data for the above-mentioned purposes; To regulatory authorities, courts and bodies as required by law or to service providers for internal investigations and reporting. The disclosure of personal information to the third parties set out

above may involve the transfer of data other jurisdictions outside the European Economic Area (“EEA”) which may include the United States. Any transmission of personal information by Dynamic Technologies Trading or its service providers outside the EEA shall be in accordance with the conditions of the GDPR. These countries may not have the same data protection laws that apply in the EEA, but Dynamic Technologies Trading will authorize its group entities or other service providers to transfer personal information to other countries only where standard contractual clauses or other safeguards permitted under the GDPR have been put in place with parties to whom personal information will be transferred. Dynamic Technologies Trading and its service providers apply appropriate information security measures designed to protect personal information in its or its service providers’ possession from unauthorized access by third parties or from any form of computer corruption.

Information Disclosed by Dynamic Technologies Trading and to Whom Dynamic Technologies Trading Discloses the Information

Dynamic Technologies Trading may share information with affiliates if the information is required to provide the product or service you have requested or to provide you the opportunity to participate in the products or services our affiliates offer. Except for the limited circumstances described below or as otherwise permitted by law, Dynamic Technologies Trading does not share nonpublic personal information about our current or former customers with any third parties.

- Dynamic Technologies Trading may share nonpublic personal information with introducing brokers for translation services. When introducing brokers provide translation services, we endeavor to protect such personal information by requiring those introducing brokers to enter into an agreement with Dynamic Technologies Trading to safeguard the confidentiality of personal information.
- When a client is referred by an introducing broker, Dynamic Technologies Trading generally shares nonpublic personal information concerning the account opening and maintenance process with the introducing broker who made the referral.
- Dynamic Technologies Trading may engage another business or person to help us identify client and demo user needs and notify clients and demo users of product and service offerings. Use of the information shared is limited to the performance of the task we request and is not used for any other purpose. These third parties are required to enter into an agreement with Dynamic Technologies Trading to safeguard the confidentiality of personal information before they provide such services. Examples of information shared are identifying information such as name, mailing address, email address and telephone number and information on account activity.
- Dynamic Technologies Trading may provide information to non-affiliated third parties, as permitted by law, in providing financial services to you.
- Dynamic Technologies Trading may provide information, as permitted by law, to government or regulatory agencies and to comply with a legal summons, court order, subpoena or a similar legal process, audit or investigation; and
- Dynamic Technologies Trading may also disclose your nonpublic personal information if you authorize such disclosure.

If you do not wish to have Dynamic Technologies Trading share nonpublic personal information with non-affiliated third parties pursuant to any of the provisions listed above, please opt out of those provisions by sending an e-mail to info@dyntech.io. Opting out will apply for all financial products or services you obtain through Dynamic Technologies Trading. Please note that you cannot opt out of any provisions if sharing of the information is required by law. Further, please note that an opt out election must be made for each separate account you hold at Dynamic Technologies Trading or with any Dynamic Technologies Trading affiliates.

Third party sites

Our communications may contain links to third party websites. As we do not control the information on these websites, you should review their privacy policies and cookies to learn about how that website may collect and use your personal information. When accessing any third party sites that may be linked you will leave this website. These third party sites are not controlled or endorsed by Dynamic Technologies Trading. Dynamic Technologies Trading is not responsible for the contents, operation or security of such sites.

Retention period

Dynamic Technologies Trading will retain personal information only for as long as required for the purposes set out above. Once the personal information is no longer required, we will take appropriate steps to dispose of any records containing your personal information, to the extent this is operationally feasible and proportionate.

Data subject rights

Where Dynamic Technologies Trading holds personal information, the owner of that information has the following rights, in certain circumstances, in relation to their personal information: Right to access any personal data held Right to have any inaccurate personal data rectified Right to restrict the use of personal data Right to request that personal data is erased Right to object to the processing of personal data Right to obtain a copy of any personal data held in electronic form (data portability) Dynamic Technologies Trading will notify you of any personal data breach affecting you that is likely to result in a high risk to your rights and freedoms. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Office of the Data Protection

Commissioner, or your local supervisory authority, if you consider that the processing of your personal information by us infringes the Data Protection Legislation. Cookies

A cookie is a small text file placed on your device that stores information about a user's use of a website. Security Technology

Dynamic Technologies Trading uses Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption technology in order to protect certain information that is submitted. This technology protects you from having your information intercepted by anyone other than Dynamic Technologies Trading while it is being transmitted to us. We work diligently to ensure that our Web sites are secure and that they meet industry standards. We also use other safeguards such as firewalls, authentication systems (e.g., passwords and personal identification numbers), and access control mechanisms to control unauthorized access to systems and data.
